Our Civil Protection Plan includes various ways for staying in contact : before, during or after a major disaster. These “means” could be used in complementarity depending on the situation and the urgency. Among these methods there are :

- **Automated “Municipal Alerts”** system to receive automated alerts of all categories (evacuation, sheltering, road closures, breakdowns, notices or others), by telephone, email, text message (depending on registration).
- **Radio medias** to transmit alert messages, as well as monitoring the situation.
 - **Priority stations to be used are : 91.7 CBC (in English); 102.7 ROUGE FM and Radio-Canada Première - Estrie 101.1 (in French)**, Other medias (radio or TV) could also be used.
- **Municipal website** www.munogden.ca
- **Newsletter** by subscription and our **bulletin “The Ogden Chronicle”**.
