# TO INTERESTED PERSONS ENTITLED TO SUBMIT A REQUEST FOR REFERENDUM APPROVAL

SECOND DRAFT BYLAW #2025.02 AMENDING ZONING BYLAW #2000-3

Following the public consultation meeting held on February 3, 2025 on draft bylaw #2025.02, Council adopted the second draft bylaw on February 3, 2025.

#### Purpose of the project and request for referendum approval:

The purpose of this draft bylaw is:

- to allow the modification of a derogatory construction without increasing the gap between the applicable standards and the derogatory situation (article 19.2) and when located in the 15-25 m band in a natural landscape of superior interest under conditions;
- to repeal the condition for the issuance of a building permit requiring, in certain situations, the payment of a contribution for park fees (section 90).

The first paragraph constitutes a provision which may be the subject of an application by interested persons, in order that a bylaw relating to this first paragraph be submitted for approval in accordance with the *Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities*.

## Interested persons

- 1) An interested person is any person who is not disqualified from voting and who meets the following conditions on February 3, 2025:
- be of full age, a Canadian citizen and not under curatorship;
- be domiciled in the zone from which an application may originate;
- have lived in Quebec for at least 6 months;
- be the owner of a building or occupant of a business establishment located in a zone from which an application may originate for at least 12 months.
- 2) Additional condition for undivided co-owners of an immovable and co-occupants of a place of business: be designated, by means of a power of attorney signed by the majority of persons who have been co-owners or co-occupants for at least 12 months, as the person entitled to sign the application on their behalf.
- 3) Condition for exercising the right to sign an application by a legal entity: any legal entity must designate from among its members, directors or employees, by resolution, a person who, on February 3, 2025, is of full age and a Canadian citizen and who is not under curatorship.

### **Conditions for a valid request:**

- clearly indicate the provision that is the subject of the request and the zone from which it originates;
- be received at the municipal office no later than February 25, 2025;
- be signed by at least 80 interested parties.
